Under the general direction of the Town Manager, the Chief of Police of the Town of Prescott Valley provides leadership, management, administration and direction for the overall operation and activities of the Town of Prescott Valley Police Department.

The minimum job requirements are experience equivalent to eight (8) years sworn supervisory/managerial level municipal law enforcement or closely related work; AND a Bachelor's degree in Police Science, Administration of Justice, Criminal Justice or closely related area. The ideal candidate must be able to obtain AZPOST certification as a Law Enforcement Officer, and must possess or be able to obtain a valid Arizona driver's license. Graduation from the FBI Academy, or similar credential will be a plus.

Residency in the Town of Prescott Valley of the new Chief of Police within a reasonable time following appointment is preferred with out-of-area relocation assistance available.

Located approximately 87 miles northwest of Phoenix in beautiful central Arizona, Prescott Valley's high desert elevation of 5,100 feet affords four seasons with mild temperatures year-round.

The department is full-service department. The department operates from a modern law enforcement facility adjacent to Town Hall.

The salary range is \$98,686 to \$138,160 and the midpoint of the range is \$118,423. The starting salary will be market competitive and commensurate with the knowledge, skills and experience of the selected candidate. The Town of Prescott Valley will provide an excellent fringe benefit program.
