

## **TRAFFIC ENGINEER CITY OF ARVADA, COLORADO**

The City of Arvada, Colorado, is seeking a Traffic Engineer. Arvada, Colorado is a beautiful, first-ring suburb of Denver with 106,433 residents, approximately 15 minutes northwest of downtown Denver and 30 minutes from Denver International Airport, with direct access to two interstates. It is home to three future stops on the Gold Line commuter rail system, to be completed in 2016. The City has strong civic leadership that balances quality of life with business and economic development for a strong and stable economy.

Under the direction of the Public Works Director, the Traffic Engineer leads a division of 10 employees. The Traffic Engineer will be responsible for planning, organizing, coordinating, directing, and supervising the work of the traffic division of the public works department.

**Qualifications and Experience:** Minimum requirements include a Bachelor's Degree in Civil or Transportation Engineering and ten (10) years' experience in traffic/transportation engineering. At least five years supervisory experience is required. A Colorado driver license is required. A Colorado Professional Engineering (P.E.) license is required and a Professional Traffic Operations Engineer (PTOE) certification is preferred.

This position requires solid knowledge of public works practices and procedures, planning, and administration and knowledge of principles and practices of traffic engineering and transportation planning, including standards, policies and technical issues.

The position will require the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with employees, citizens, and elected officials. Strong leadership, interpersonal, analytical and managerial skills are essential.

**Compensation:** The salary range for the Traffic Engineer position is \$87,624 - \$119,812. The City offers a competitive salary and generous benefit package that includes, health, dental, vision, vacation and sick leaves, short and long-term disability, and retirement benefits.
