Duties involve providing direct psychiatric services to clients including comprehensive evaluation, diagnosis, treatment planning, psychotherapy, medical evaluation services and medication, clinical documentation and reporting.

The ideal candidate will possess considerable knowledge, skills and abilities in providing and supervising psychiatric services and programs in the areas of mental health, substance abuse and intellectual disabilities.
