Planning and engineering projects at the Dayton airport include multiple short and long-term construction plans related to airfield/airspace, facility development, land-use, commercial development, infrastructure projects, roadways, ground transport, and studies related to the optimization of airport relates processes, operations and facilities. For example, in 2019 the Planning & Engineering Manager will oversee the Airport Master Plan update the Strategic Growth and Business Plan which have a progressive emphasis on environmental sustainability.
