

CITY ASSESSOR
City of Hampton, Virginia

The City of Hampton, Virginia is seeking well qualified candidates for its City Assessor. This is an exciting opportunity to live and work in a community located on the southern end of the Virginia Peninsula, bordering on Hampton Roads and the Chesapeake Bay. Encompassing approximately 54.77 square miles of land and 17.3 square miles of water with 137,000 residents, Hampton is part of a dynamic metropolitan region with five other cities with a population over 100,000. The City boasts a strong military and technology presence. Langley Air Force Base is home of the First Fighter Wing. NASA Langley Research Center, where America's first astronauts were trained, is now a major center for aviation research. Hampton University and Thomas Nelson Community College are located within the city limits and several colleges and universities are located in nearby cities.

The City provides a variety of historical, cultural and recreational activities including the NASA Visitor Center. The Hampton Arts Commission sponsors cultural performances and attractions. Numerous recreational facilities are located in Hampton including a nine acre beachfront park, community parks, tennis courts, picnic areas, swimming pools, athletic fields, boat launches and public and private golf courses throughout the city. Hampton is home to Boo Williams, a uniquely designed 135,000 square foot multi-purpose indoor facility that includes basketball and volleyball courts and indoor hockey fields.

The City operates under a Council-Manager form of government. The City Council is comprised of seven members, including an elected Mayor. A Vice Mayor is selected from the other six Council members every two years. The Council appoints a City Manager, who is responsible for the City's day-to-day operation, City Attorney and City Clerk. The City has a FY 18 general fund budget of \$467M and 2,600 full and part-time employees. Hampton is a 1972, 2002, and a 2014 All-America City awardee.

The City Assessor serves as a member of the Executive Management Team and is responsible for the leadership and service management of the assessment program for commercial, industrial and real estate property for tax purposes and administration of the city-wide real estate property appraisal system. The City Assessor manages a department of 17 full-time employees with a FY 18 budget of \$1.1M. The position reports to the Assistant City Manager.

The successful candidate will be a graduate of an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree in finance, real estate, business administration, public administration or related field of study. A Master's degree is preferred. The position requires six to nine years of progressively responsible managerial experience in directing the staff and services of a comprehensive local government or state real estate assessment program.

Salary is commensurate with education and experience.

The successful candidate is required to establish principal residency within the Hampton city limits within twelve months of assuming the position and must maintain principal residency for the tenure of the position.
