Major Duties and Responsibilities

The Risk Manager reports to the Director of Finance and is responsible for insurance and risk management services for the City, Mecklenburg County, Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools and other entities. The Risk Manager advises in the development of enterprise-wide risk management strategies to keep employees safe and minimize total cost of risk; and directs the activities of the Risk Management Division, including risk financing, insurance, property/casualty claims, workers compensation, and safety and loss control.

Minimum Qualifications

Bachelor's degree in Business Administration, Insurance, Risk Management or related field, including course work in safety, from an accredited institution. Considerable experience managing a large and complex risk management program, including property, liability and workers compensation claims administration; safety and loss control; self-funded/reinsured and conventionally insured programs; and supervision of professional and support staff.

Knowledge of: risk management and risk financing practices and procedures; principles of risk identification and loss prevention; applicable law; contractual risk transfer techniques; litigation management and claims investigation and resolution; National Safety Council and OSHA standards and guidelines; Federal Emergency Management regulations and requirements; and general principles of governmental finance and accounting.

Ability to: hire, develop and retain high quality employees; supervise and provide leadership to a professional staff and contractors; communicate effectively and professionally orally and in writing; organize, conduct/facilitate productive and effective meetings; negotiate effectively and resolve conflicts; and maintain a high level of confidentiality.
