The City of Hallandale Beach is searching for a City Manager. Serving as the Chief Executive Officer, he/she will be an experienced, service-oriented, and innovative professional. Home to over 39,500 residents, the City of Hallandale Beach has a total FY 2018/2019 budget of approximately \$137 million with about 435 full time and 93 part-time employees. The City is governed by a Commission-Manager form of government consisting of five elected officials; a Mayor, a Vice-Mayor and three Commissioners, all of whom as a body, establish legislative policies. All are elected at large and serve staggered, four-year terms. The City does not have term limits and it is not uncommon for Commissioners to serve multiple terms. The City Commission appoints the City Manager and the City Attorney.

He/She will have a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university, with a major in administration, management or a related field, Master's degree preferred. He/She will have five (5) Years of progressively responsible experience in municipal and/or local government and At least five (5) Years as executive level manager overseeing at least 200 employees. The successful candidate will be a member in good standing or eligible for membership with International City/County Management Association (ICMA).

The City anticipates a starting salary within the annual range of **\$160,000 to \$200,000** dependent on qualifications and experience.
